EEC GRANT PROGRAMS

1. Coordinated Family and Community Engagement (CFCE) Grant

The Coordinated Family and Community Engagement Programs (CFCE) are locally based programs serving families with children birth through school age. The Coordinated Family and Community Engagement Grant is a consolidation of the Community Partnerships for Children Programs (CPC), Massachusetts Family Network Programs (MFN), Parent Child Home Programs (PCHP) and Joint Family Support Programs (JFSP).

There are five main goals of the CFCE program:

- Increase knowledge of and accessibility to high-quality early education and care programs and services for families with children prenatal through school-age.
- Promote parent education, family engagement and early literacy.
- Facilitate collaboration and community planning between local partners and other community stake holders, including parents.
- Provide support and information to families with children transitioning between and among early education and care settings, home and school, and
- Support early education and care programs across the public and private sectors in delivering high-quality services.

Through direct services and/or referrals, local CFCE programs provide a variety of services, which include providing families access to:

- child development information;
- transition information and supports;
- assistance with meeting basic needs;
- timely support in periods of family crisis;
- high quality, specific and up-to-date information and referrals.
- family literacy and school readiness activities;
- family and community events;
- parent leadership opportunities; and
- information about early education and care opportunities and other community resources that support parents in their role as their child's first teacher.

2. Educator and Provider Support (EPS) Grant

The EPS grant focuses on 3 core areas of the professional development system: educator and provider planning, coaching and mentoring, and competency development.

Grant Goals:

- Educators are supported to increase competency and earn a degree, certificate, or credential in early childhood education or a related field.
- Educators have access to the resources and supports (coaching and mentoring) to set and achieve professional and academic goals.
- Providers (programs) receive supports and resources to achieve and maintain accreditation.
- Providers (programs) are supported in upward movement on EEC's Quality Rating and Improvement System (QRIS).
- Educators and Providers (programs) are working on specific activities based on individualized professional development plans to achieve one of the grant's goals.

Core Areas:

- Educator and Provider (program) Planning: To help educators and providers (programs) create and implement individualized pathways and plans that include an assessment of knowledge, skills, and abilities (competency) and are reflective of the educator's experience, expertise, and individual career and academic goals.
- Coaching and Mentoring: To provide the necessary support services including individual career and academic advising to help educators and providers (programs) make informed and appropriate educational choices that advance professional growth.
- Competency Development: To support the attainment of knowledge, skills, and abilities through qualified professional development that addresses theory to practice, utilizes reflection, and is individualized to meet educator and provider (program) needs.

Each partnership is responsible for providing professional development support services such as coaching and mentoring)and opportunities to early education and care and out of school time educators and providers (programs) in Massachusetts. All professional development opportunities are included on EEC's Online Professional Development Calendar and the FY2013 Educator and Provider Support Grantees Professional Development Course Catalogue. All educators must be included in the Professional Qualifications Registry (PQR) and provide EPS leads and/or partnership members with their PQR ID number to participate in professional development supported by the EPS grant. 3. Early Childhood Mental Health Consultation Grant

The Mental Health Consultation Services Grant is intended to support a statewide mental health consultation services model that meets the needs of the early education and care field. The objectives of the model are as follows:

- Promote the healthy social and emotional development of all children, particularly those children whose emotional development is compromised by poverty, biological or family risk factors, or other circumstances which may contribute to toxic levels of stress;
- Build the capacity of early education and care program staff to enhance children's learning through positive, nurturing interactions with children and with their families and to address the needs of children who exhibit behavioral challenges;
- Attend to social-emotional needs of children so they are ready to learn and successful in their early education;
- Reduce the number of children who are suspended or expelled from Early Education and Care funded programs;
- Promote collaboration for better access to supportive services for children and their families; and
- Maximize resources by ensuring that certain mental health interventions are funded, when appropriate, through insurance payments.

4. Child Care Resource and Referral Agencies (CCR&R) (current)

The current contracts have been awarded according to its three main purposes, to provide:

- **Level I:** high-quality *subsidy management* services for EEC subsidized families and providers/Systems and information and referral services for EEC subsidized families and providers/Systems that accept subsidies;
- **Level II:** *information and referral services* for EEC subsidized and non-EEC subsidized families and providers throughout the Commonwealth;
- **Level III:** *enhanced consumer education* services for families throughout the Commonwealth.

Other EEC Programs/Initiatives

1. Quality Rating and Improvement Scale (QRIS)

A Quality Rating & Improvement System (QRIS) is a method to assess, improve, and communicate the level of quality in early care & education and after-school settings (Stair Steps to Quality, Anne W. Mitchell (2005); United Way Success by Six, p. 4). The MA QRIS offers guidance to professionals in early education and care and out of school time settings on a path towards quality, recognizing that higher expectations of programs must be matched with increased supports that include a better-articulated career ladder, financial incentives, and professional development and technical assistance, which are grounded in the science of child development. QRIS are similar to other consumer rating systems, in that they "rate" goods or services to provide customers with a better understanding about the quality of that item. The Massachusetts Department of Early Education and Care (EEC) formally began developing a QRIS during the spring of 2008. Twenty other states have implemented QRIS over the past decade and many more states are in the development process.
